MAC adheres to the Fiqh Council of North America (FCNA) criteria in determining the date of Eid Al-Adha, which is the day after Arafah and which will be contingent on the announcement by the Hajj authorities in Makkah of the day of 'Arafah.

MAC wishes the Muslims in Canada and around the world an Eid Mubarak filled with happiness and joy. As we celebrate these glorious days of Hajj, this is an opportune time for our community to connect to their faith's history and commemorate the events that shaped the history of the holy places.
