#### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

Ending the school year on a positive note is not only important for our students but also for the teachers as the Messenger of Allah (saw) is reported to have said, "Indeed, deeds are based on their endings." (Bukhari, 6607). In other words, deeds are judged by Allah according to how they end. Ending the school year on a positive note is also important in establishing a growth mindset and setting the stage for future successes. In this hands-on, online micro course, teachers will plan for the last days of school using the Prophetic model of teaching with tarbiyah via Online Modules and a set of carefully curated teacher tested resources.

#### **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

Students will be able to:

- 1. Integrate the Prophetic (saw) tarbiyah framework of teaching and learning
- Use lessons from Surah An-Nasr to design learning experiences that inspire selfassessment, reflection, learning, and a growth mindset for students as well as for teachers.
- 3. Use data from assessments and surveys to plan the next steps.
- Develop innovative and student-centered learning materials and processes that are research driven and incorporate the effective use of technology to advance student learning.
- Model the collaborative construction of knowledge by interacting, collaborating, and publishing with students, colleagues, and experts employing a variety of digital environments and media.
